## Ideas for Teaching Japanese How to put word / picture cards on the board

Materials required	Reusable adhesive (e.g. Blue-tack)
Prerequisite	You need to have a whiteboard or a blackboard in your classroom

Do you use word cards or picture cards in your class? I sometimes use them like this.



It looks neat and organized, right? But previously, I have often got into a situation where I wanted to put my cards on the board but then realized that there wasn't enough space left for them! Have you found yourself in a situation like this? Are you looking for a good solution? If you are, then here is one simple technique you can use in your class.



It is very easy; paste reusable adhesive on the places where you want to put your cards on. You do it in advance. That's it. In this way, you will not only be able to put the cards quickly, but also keep the board well-organized during the class by knowing exactly where to/not to write on the board.
